Item 1: Welcome by the President and Introductory Remarks: Dr. V N Bindal, welcomed the members to the meeting and said that as per the Rules & Regulations of the Forum, the main item on the Agenda for today's meeting was the election of the Office Bearers of the Management Committee for the next two years 2009-2011. It was not only the team work of the Members of the Management Committee, but the support that it received from the Members of the Forum that the Forum is now a Registered Body. It was only appropriate for him to highlight the achievements of the Forum through its various Area Committees

He said that the Publication Committee chaired by Dr. R Bhattacharyya had been doing exceedingly good work through the publication of the Forum's Newsletter, for which credit goes also to a large measure to the efforts made by Shri G K Arora, the compiler and editor of the Newsletter. Through this Newsletter, the Members of the Forum have been getting information on various aspects and the Committee has been making all efforts to make this publication even more informative and useful

Another major achievement of the Forum was the Scholarships & Awards which had been instituted by the Forum, through the recommendations of the Scholarship Committee of which Director, NPL was himself the chairman and was being represented by Dr. Anil Kumar Gupta, and on which the Chief of Administration, NPL, represented by Shri Balraj Singh was also a member. Both Dr. Anil Kumar Gupta and Shri Balraj Singh had additionally contributed to the successful operation of the Scholarship Committee by instituting awards in the memories of their Fathers.

Dr. Bindal said that it was a matter of pride for the Forum also that Dr. Anil Kumar Gupta had very recently taken over as Director of the CSIR's Advanced Materials Research Institute, Bhopal [Earlier known as Regional Research Laboratory, Bhopal]. The Forum received

this good news by the customary clapping of hands and requested Dr. Bindal to formally convey these sentiments of joy to Dr. Gupta on behalf of the Forum for his very valuable contributions to the Forum

Dr. Bindal added that with Dr. Anil Kumar Gupta having left, NPL, at a time when shortly the Scholarship Committee will have to initiate action for the selection of meriting children for the Scholarships & Awards for the year 2009, Director, NPL will now have to be requested to either Chair the meetings of the Scholarship Committee himself or else nominate some other Scientist to represent him on that Committee in place of Dr. Anil Kumar Gupta. He also added that while a presentation had been made by Shri V P Wasan at the last meeting of the Forum held on 16th March 2009, indicating that the Awards instituted by the Forum were also open to Grand Children of Members of the Forum and informing them about the procedure to be followed for applying for these awards, he wanted to bring this again to the notice of the Members, so that the committee could also get some applications from the Grand Children of the Members of the Forum. The Scholarships & Awards are being run by putting bulk of the money contributed by their initiators in Fixed Deposits and using the interest earned on these deposits to ensure that they were of a perpetual nature.

Dr. V S Panwar and Shri V P Wasan have been making very valuable contributions in regard to making the necessary preparations for presentation of the Scholarships & Awards on the NPL Open Day observed by NPL in the month of September.

Another very significant contribution by the Forum was the work of revision of the Chart on S.I. Units of Measurement which had been taken up by NPL at the initiative of Dr. Kailash Chandra, the Chairman of the Scientific Affairs Committee, and the very valuable contributions that had been made by him and Dr. S V Gupta in this regard. The earlier chart was made a long time back under the guidance of Dr. Kailash Chandra, the then Head of the Standards Division of NPL, at the time when Dr. A P Mitra was Director, NPL. It was learnt that the draft of the revised Chart, for which Dr. P C Kothari had also made very significant contributions, was being finalized, and hopefully it will be published very soon.

Dr. Bindal said that the various achievements of the Forum would not have been possible but for the encouragement that it received from Dr. Vikram Kumar. The Forum has been provided a Room, a telephone and some furniture also. The Forum's Newsletter has been getting financial support by way of advertisement from NPL. The members have been put on the mailing list for 'Sameeksha' and they have also been getting copies of the Telephone Directory of NPL to facilitate their interaction with their former colleagues. Invitations are also being received for participation in the various functions organized by NPL. It is the moral responsibility of the Members of the Forum to acknowledge the receipts of such invitations even if they are not able to participate in them. The Forum had also made a request to put our Forum on the website of NPL. In principle it has been agreed by NPL to provide a link to our Forum on its website, but since we are not in a position to afford a website of our own, the matter is being pursued by Dr. R Bhartacharya.

The Medical Affairs Committee had been addressing itself to the various issues which the members face, but some of these issues which are specific to all the Autonomous Institutions have evaded any solution so far. It is however, heartening to learn through Shri G K Arora about an Office Memorandum issued by the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, and put on their website, that the Essentiality Certificate and signing of the Bills/ Receipts by the specialist who had recommended a procedure, has been done away with, and the Medical Reimbursement Form has also been modified accordingly. This Memo also gives an illustrative list of cases which are to be treated as "Emergency" which has been one of the major problems faced by the members. The contents of this OM will also be published in the next issue of the Forum's Newsletter.

The registration of the Forum is accompanied with associated problems also as our application for Income Tax Exemption was turned down last year with particular reference to the Aims & Objects of the Forum as reflected in the Memorandum of Association of the Forum. After the Resolution adopted by the Forum for Re-formulation of the Aims & Objects [at the General Body Meeting held on 30th April 2008], the Registrar of Societies was approached to approve the Memorandum of Association incorporating the Re-formulated Aims & Objects, but we were required to complete a number of other formalities and furnish additional information before our request could be entertained. The necessary action has since been taken and Shri G K Arora has furnished the detailed information to the Registrar of Societies. It is only after this issue is solved will we be able to take up again the issue of Income Tax Exemption for the Forum. In the meanwhile the Forum has got a PAN Number for it.

Another issue relates to the Auditing of the Accounts of the Forum which have so far been audited internally by Shri P K Mittal. Now that the Forum is a Registered Society, it is necessary to have the accounts audited by a Chartered accountant and this issue also appears on the agenda for today's meeting.

For making the Room allotted to the Forum functional, action is being taken by Dr. V S Panwar and by Dr. A P Jain. Dr. Kailash Chandra had suggested the members of the Management Committee contributing Rs. 1000/- each, and appealing to members of the Forum also to make generous financial contributions. He has now suggested that the members may voluntary contribute in multiples of Rs. 100/- so that the room could be properly equipped. The room has been designed keeping in view the availability of an air-conditioner, in the absence of which there is no proper ventilation. Members are requested to make voluntary contributions and suggestions to make effective use of this room and to offer usable furniture and computer which they could spare for the Forum's Room.

Dr. Bindal said that while he was happy that the members of the Forum were coming forward to share their joys and donate funds for meeting some of the expenses of the Forum, we gather here also to share the sorrows of our members. Before moving over to the next item of Agenda, he requested Shri Arora to brief the members in this regard.

The Members were informed about the bereavement of **Shri Jai Bhagwan Soni** with the demise of his wife Mrs. Vijay Shri Soni, and the set back that the forum had suffered on account of the demise of **Mrs. Veena Roonwal**. Condolence Resolutions were passed on their demise and the members observed two minutes silence to pay their homage to the departed souls.

Shri Arora then informed the members of the following joys that some of the Members shared with the house at this meeting:

9. **Dr. C P Sharma** had taken over as CSIR Emeritus Scientist at IIT, Delhi, w.e.f 09. 03. 2009.

Shri Arora also mentioned about other such information in the past which had been reported in the last issue No. 5 of the Forum's Newsletter dated September 2008, and requested Members to pass on such information to the Compiler of the Newsletter for reporting in its future issues also.

Item 2. Confirmation of the Minutes of the Meeting held on 16. 03. 2009: The Minutes of the meeting held on March 16, 2009 had already been circulated to the members along with the notice for the meeting. As no comments had been received, the Minutes of the Meeting were confirmed.

Item 3. Consideration of the Annual Report of the previous year: The Status Report by the Secretary (*Annexure 'B'*), presents the Report since the last General Body meeting held on 30th April 2008. Copies of this were circulated to the members at the time of the meeting and its highlights were briefly presented. In particular attention of the Members was drawn to Para 2.5 of this Report relating to the furnishing of information about themselves on the lines approved by the Management Committee at its meeting held on 27. 10. 2008, and also to Para 2.7 reporting the decision taken at the same meeting to have a Calendar of the Meetings of the Forum and also of the Management Committee for the Calendar year 2009. Accordingly the next meeting of the Forum was now scheduled to be held on 26th, 27th or 28th August 2009, depending upon the availability of the Venue for holding the meeting on these days and other relevant factors. The agenda for that meeting will be decided by the Management Committee at its meeting tentatively scheduled to be held on August 10th, 11th or 12th 2009. The report by the Secretary was noted by the members with satisfaction.

Item 4. Audited Report for 2008-2009: Pending the preparation of the Audited Report from a Chartered Accountant, the Internally Audited Report prepared by Shri P K Mittal (*Annexure 'C'*) was presented, and the same was approved.

Item 5. Appointment of Auditor: M/s N. Sharma & Associates, Chartered Accountants, V-6, First Floor, Green Park Extension, New Delhi – 110 016, who have also been auditing the Accounts of the Metrology Society of India, were approached to undertake the job of auditing the Accounts of our Forum. Shri Naresh Sharma Proprietor of this Firm, vide his letter dated April 14, 2009, has conveyed to us the acceptance to do this job for the financial years 2008-2009 and 2009-2010 for which they shall be charging Rs. 2,000/- per year towards the audit (plus service tax as applicable).

In anticipation of the Approval by the Members to the Appointment of M/s N. Sharma & Associates as the Auditors of the accounts of our Forum, the accounting records and books were made available to them by Shri V P Wasan and they have already undertaken the job of Auditing our Forum's Accounts for the year 2008 – 2009. Shri Naresh Sharma, who had also been invited to attend the meeting indicated briefly the action already taken by the firm so far.

The Charges quoted by the Firm were considered quite reasonable and were approved. The Members further authorized the New Management Committee which was to be constituted vide the next item on the Agenda to Accept and adopt the Audited report for the financial year 2008-2009 to be furnished by M/s N. Sharma & Associates on behalf of the General Body for further action, and place the same before them for formal approval at the next meeting.

6. Election of the Office Bearers of the Management Committee for 2009-2011: As had been indicated in the notice for the meeting, Shri P K Mittal, Performed the duties of the Returning Officer, within the framework of the Rules & Regulations of the Forum. The following Office Bearers were declared unanimously elected and the result of the election was handed over by Shri Mittal to Dr. V N Bindal – the new President of the Forum.

The last General Body Meeting of the Forum was held on October 27, 2008 which was essentially a single point agenda at which the Resolution that had been passed unanimously at the General Body Meeting held on April 30, 2009 regarding the Re-formulated Aims & Objects of the Forum (to replace the Aims & Objects constituting Para 3 of the Memorandum of Association under which the Forum had been registered with the Registrar of Societies) were confirmed by 75 of the 79 members who had attended that meeting and the Minutes of the meeting held on 30. 04. 2008 were also confirmed. SECRETARY'S REPORT

Twentieth Meeting of the Forum and also (the Sixth Annual General Body Meeting –Thursday, April 16, 2009)
Venue – TEC Conference Room, National Physical Laboratory, New Delhi

1. Annual General Body Meetings of the Forum: The Forum got registered as a Society on 27th October 2007. Prior to that the Forum had four Annual General Body Meetings on 25. 11. 2003 (**Fifth Meeting** of the Forum), 02. 05. 2005 (**Ninth Meeting**), 21. 03. 2006 (**Eleventh Meeting**), and 14. 08. 2007 (**Fifteenth Meeting**). The First Annual General Body Meeting, after the Forum got registered as a Society, was held on 30. 04. 2008 (**Seventeenth Meeting**). As per clause 11.2 of the Rules & Regulations of the Forum which were also published on pages 9-12 of Issue No. 4, of the Forum's Newsletter, dated September 2007, under which the Forum was subsequently registered as a Society, "**One of the meetings of the Forum shall be the Annual General Body Meeting**".

The Forum has had its **Eighteenth** and **Nineteenth** Meetings on 27. 10. 2008 and 16. 03. 2009 respectively. The present **Twentieth Meeting** of the Forum constitutes the **Sixth Annual General Body Meeting**. The General Body Meeting held on 27. 10. 2008 was essentially a single point agenda meeting at which the Resolution that had been passed unanimously at the Annual General Body Meeting held on April 30, 2008 regarding the Re-formulated Aims & Objects of the Forum (to replace the Aims & Objects constituting Para 3 of the Memorandum of Association under which the Forum had been registered with the Registrar of Societies) were confirmed by 75 of the 79 members who had attended that meeting, and the Minutes of the meeting held on 30. 04. 2008 were also confirmed.

2. Developments since the Last Annual General Body Meeting held on 30. 04. 2008: Since the Fifth Annual General Body meeting of the Forum held on 30. 04. 2008 a number of developments had taken place and it is only appropriate that the members of the Forum are apprised of these developments.

2. 1 On September 25, 2008 – the NPL Open Day – Dr. Vikram Kumar, Director, NPL had given out the certificates and awards to the children of the NPL Staff Members, who had been approved by the Scholarship Committee of the Forum under the Chairmanship of Dr. Anil Kumar Gupta. It was very heartening to note that he himself and Shri Balraj Singh had also instituted NPL Former Scientists Forum Awards, thereby increasing the number of Scholarships & Awards instituted by the Forum to ten. **No application for any of the Awards had been received from the Grand-children of the Members of the Forum.**

2. 2 The Fifth Issue of the Forum's Newsletter dated September 2008 had been published, and despite his other commitments Dr. Anil Kumar Gupta had agreed to release it at the Forum's Nineteenth Meeting held on 27th October 2008. Dr. Gupta in his address before the release of the Newsletter said that the publication of the Laboratory's historic document - "**Diamond Jubilee Document**" - would not have been possible if this effort had not received support from the members of the NPL Former Scientists Forum and, in particular from Dr. V N Bindal, Dr. K K Mahajan, Dr. Ashok Kumar Gupta, Dr. P C Jain, Shri G K Arora, Shri S M Dhawan and Shri R C Dhawan. He said that the Members of the Forum had contributed very significantly to the growth of NPL and it would be worthwhile if this information could be pooled for attempting any other historical document on NPL in future.

2. 3 The Management Committee of the Forum at its meeting held on 06. 06. 2008, had considered the suggestions made by the Welfare Committee chaired by Dr. R G Sharma, and the following four suggestions were sent to DG, CSIR by the Secretary of the Forum, suggesting also a meeting with him for presenting our views to him in regard to these suggestions:

1. Pension should be @ 60% of the last pay drawn instead of 50% as at present and that the Family Pension may also be enhanced by 10%.
2. Dearness Pay should be treated as Basic Pay for calculation of Pension
3. Enhanced Pension proposed by the Sixth CPC may start at the age of 75 years instead of 80 years.
4. Leave Travel Concession should be given to pensioners at par with the regular employees.

However CSIR vide its letter dated 10th October had issued instructions relating to the implementation of the Sixth Central Pay Commission to the SBI, Main Branch, New Delhi. Accordingly pension at partly enhanced rates and 40 % of the Arrears computed accordingly, were credited to the accounts of the Pensioners by the SBI in November 2008. Subsequently NPL has issued Pension/Family Pension Payment Orders as per their entitlement in January 2009, but the implementation of the same has yet to take place.

2. 4 The Management Committee at its meeting held on 06. 06. 2008 also constituted the 'Sub-committee on Superstitions' of the Scientific Affairs Committee:

It was decided that this Committee would compile information on the prevailing Superstitions & Myths and the real facts about them, as they worked as a Cancer in Society, against which younger generation in particular required to be safeguarded.

2. 5 Following the suggestion made by Dr. Anil Kumar Gupta, at Para 2.2 above, the Management Committee of the Forum at its meeting held on 27. 02. 2009. endorsed the suggestion made by the Secretary to request all the Members to furnish information about themselves on the following lines:

1. Full Name, Recorded Date of Birth and the actual date of Birth, if different) and Place of Birth.
2. Parentage, and the influence of the parents, brothers, sisters, or guardians in shaping their career
3. Educational career and the influence of the teachers starting from High School/ Metric etc , carrying information about the Institution/ University/ Subject, year and their special achievements. In case of Doctorate Degree Holders, also the title of their doctoral thesis, and the names of their guides.
4. Career before joining National Physical Laboratory, and career development during association with NPL, starting from the first post (including Research Assistantship etc) till their duration of association with the Laboratory, the last post held, and the reason for leaving the Laboratory.
5. Guidance to others in their career development, and Information about their associates and other contemporaries with whom they had special interaction or who helped them in their career development to the extent they can recall, viz. their dates of birth, period of association with NPL, specialization, and date/ year of expiry (in case already deceased)
6. Areas of Specialization, and highlights about their research and other publications, participation in national/ international conferences, deputation assignments, specialized training etc. within the country and abroad
7. The major achievements for which they can lay a just claim during their association with NPL, including Planning/ Execution/ Implementation of Scientific as well as Administrative Programmes and Organization of Special Events/ Lectures/ Reference Publications etc
8. The activities in which associated after severing connection with the Laboratory. For members who left NPL before their retirement from this Laboratory, the institutions served, the positions held etc.
9. Honours, Awards and Recognitions received e.g. Fellowships of the Learned Societies within India and Abroad, indicating also the year of the recognition. Special Lectures invited to deliver, and association with the Advisory Boards of various Journals etc.
10. Special Events of historical significance held during their association with NPL, and any documents of historical significance of the Laboratory that they have.
11. National and International personalities – Nobel Laureates, Scientists, Academicians, and other personalities - that they have intimately known and who have influenced them in their career development.
12. Hobbies in the younger age and the present hobbies e.g writing of prose/ poetry/ indoor/ outdoor games/ fine arts, collection of stamps/ coins, gardening etc. and any significant achievements therein, as also their present pastime, viz. study of literature, reviewing books, viewing Educational and Quiz Programmes/ Films/ Serials on T V./ Solving Puzzles etc.
13. Information about their family – wife, children, brothers, sisters - their careers and welfare.
14. Any events of special significance which they may like to mention.

Members are requested to furnish information about themselves as per the above-guidelines, **preferably in First Person.**

2. 6 As per the decision of the Management Committee Meeting held on 27. 02. 2009 the 19th Meeting of the Forum was held on 16. 03. 2009, with its main Agenda being the inauguration of the 80-Plus Club of the Forum by Dr. Vikram Kumar, Director, NPL, and to honour 16 Members of the Club as per the recommendations of the Programme Committee, by presenting to them (1) 80-Plus Club Certificate designed by Shri V P Wasan, (2) Citations prepared by Shri G K Arora and (3) Mementoes of the Forum specially designed for the Members of the 80-Plus Club. **The Minutes of this Meeting have been circulated to the Members along with the Notice for the meeting dated 30. 03. 2009 for confirmation.**

2. 7 The Management Committee at its Meeting held on 06. 03. 2009 considered the suggestion of Dr. Kailash Chandra to have a Calendar for the Meetings of the Management Committee, the Area Committees and the Forum, for the year 2009.

It was decided to fix the Meetings of the **Management Committee** starting from 11.00.A.M. preceded by the meeting of some Area Committee on the same day, and at least **four such meetings** may be fixed during the Months of **January, April, August, and October** depending on the availability of suitable dates and venue for these meetings. Similarly, **at least three meetings of the Forum** may also be held in **Feb/March, August and November** – one of them being the Annual General Body Meeting of the Forum. Accordingly **the following Tentative Calendar for the various meetings of the Forum has been drawn up for the year 2009,** subject to the availability of the Venue for holding these meetings on any of the suggested three dates:

2. 8 The Management Committee at its meeting held on 27. 02. 2009 also decided that the names of the Members who had defaulted by way of non-payment of Arrears of the Membership fee may be removed from the Membership List of the Forum.

3. Forum's Numerical Strength: In addition to the removal of the names of the defaulting members of the Forum from the Membership List, the Forum's strength has depleted on account of the demise of Dr. A F Chhapgar on 07. 02. 2008, Dr. T K Saksena on 23. 12. 2008 and Dr. A R Verma on 04. 03. 2009. Condolence Resolutions passed on their demise have been sent to the Members of the bereaved families. Subsequently, Mrs.Veena Roonwal has also expired on 10th April 2009 and Condolence Resolution on her demise figures as an added item of agenda for today's meeting.
