Minutes of the Twenty-First Meeting of the Management Committee of the NPL Former Scientists Forum, held on Tuesday, April 15, 2008 at 10.00 A.M. in the Director's Conference Room, NPL

Dr. R Bhattacharyya (Member) had regretted his inability to attend the meeting. Dr. O P Bahl (Vice-President), and Dr. S P Varma (Member) were absent.

1. Welcome and Introductory Remarks by the President: Dr. Bindal welcomed the members to the meeting. He was happy to inform that the Room allotted to the Forum had also been provided a telephone connection, which had also been indicated on the notice issued for today's meeting. He said that for various reasons which will become apparent, the Meeting of the Management Committee was being held after a long time and accordingly we have a large number of items on the Agenda.

2. Passing of a Resolution on the demise of Dr. A F Chhapgar: The Management Committee was informed that Dr. A F Chhapgar, had expired on 7th February 2008. The immediate cause of his death was brain haemorrhage. The Secretary then read out a resolution where after the members observed two-minute silence, and he advised him to send a copy of it to his son Shri Fram A Chhapgar.

3. Confirmation of the Minutes of the Twentieth Meeting of the Management Committee held on June 20, 2007: As explained by the Secretary in his Status Report, there were no comments from any of the Members. The Minutes of the meeting were confirmed.

4. Follow-up Action on the various decisions taken at the above meeting; The follow-up action on the decisions taken at the above meeting as reported by the Secretary in his report, was noted.

5. Status Report by the Secretary; The Secretary, briefly presented the report which had been tabled at the meeting (Annexure A). He, however, pointed out, as indicated in NOTE at the top of his Report, about the inadvertent error in the numbering of the Items of the Agenda which had been circulated to the members vide his letter dated, 8th April 2008. A copy of the revised letter incorporating the correct numbering of the various items, (also referred to in the Status Report), was placed on the table at the time of the meeting (Annexure B).

6. Status Report by the Treasurer and Appointment of a Chartered Accountant for the Forum: The Treasurer presented the Un-Audited Report of Accounts of the Forum. Separate accounts had been maintained in respect of the Forum and the Scholarships and Awards. These are enclosed herewith (Annexures C & D).

It was observed that as per the decision of the Management Committee, which had been endorsed by the Scholarship Committee, no amount had been charged from the Scholarships/ Awards instituted by various members of the Forum. It was decided that these may henceforth be charged as overhead expenses during the next Financial Year and credited to the Saving Fund Account of the Forum.

It was also observed that for some of the Scholarships and Awards the Accounts could not be opened as the Bank insisted on PAN Number of the Forum. For this the Secretary had drawn up the necessary application as per the spadework done by the President, Dr. V S Panwar undertook the responsibility of getting the same processed.

As regards Auditing of Accounts of the Forum, it was felt that it may be ascertained whether they need to be audited by a Chartered Accountant, and if so, efforts may be made to associate the children/ relatives of the Members of the Forum who are Chartered Accountants, and may be willing to do this service for the Forum free of cost. For the present, as per the past practice, the Secretary may ascertain from Shri P K Mittal to do the Internal Auditing of the Accounts for 2007-2008 also.,

7. Reformulation of the Aims & Objects of the Forum: As had been indicated by the Secretary in his Report, the need for Reformulation of the Aims and Objects of the Forum had been felt because the Income Tax Authorities had rejected our application for exemption from payment of Income Tax. Accordingly after consultations with the Income Tax Advisor, the President had revised the Aims and Objects of the Forum. These, along with the existing Aims and Objects had been circulated to the members of the Committee.

The Committee considered the Reformulated Aims & Objects of the Forum, and approved them with minor changes as under:

3. The 'Forum' shall be a social / professional non-profit organization with the following aims and objects:

3.1 To organize lectures / talks of common interest to the Members by experts in various fields for exchange of ideas and opinion.

3.2 To contribute towards the promotion of science by arranging talks and demonstration- lectures on career counseling in schools & colleges to create interest in pursuing science.

3.3 To publish articles, books and arrange talks for the popularization of science and for creating awareness against social drawbacks like 'superstition' etc in the interest of society, in general.

3.4 To associate with NPL and other organizations for undertaking scientific/ technical projects of relevance to the socio-economic fabric or development of the country.

3.5 To organize independently, or in association with other scientific and technical institutions/ organizations, activities like symposia, seminars, conferences, training courses and workshops, and to publish the proceedings etc. for the advancement of knowledge and education.

3.6 To invite any Indian/ Foreign Scientist/ Dignitary to share his/ her expertise with Members, and to interact with them from time-to-time.

3.7 To institute awards and scholarships for the advancement of education.

8. Approval to the Induction of New Members to the Forum: The Committee approved the Induction of all the twelve new members to the Forum as placed before it in the Status Report by the Secretary.

9. Replacement of Dr. Ved Ram Singh by Dr. R G Sharma as a Member of the Management Committee and as Chairman of the Welfare Committee: The reasons necessitating this change after the President's obtaining the consent of Dr. Ved Ram Singh by e-mail had been indicated by the Secretary in his Status Report. The Committee welcomed the joining of Dr. R G Sharma as a new Member of the Management Committee with a clap of hands, and also welcomed his assuming the Chairmanship of the Welfare Committee.

10. Reports of the of Area Committees: As Dr. O P Bahl was absent at the meeting, no report on the **Medical Affairs Committee** was available. Dr. V S Panwar, informed that he had been passing on the relevant information relating to Medical and other matters published by P & RPA Bulletin published by Pensioners and Retired Persons Association, Janakpuri, (of which he is also a member) to Shri G K Arora. The Committee was also informed that the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare had now started notifying its Office Memoranda on its website only, and no information of interest to CGHS Beneficiaries was now available from this or other supplementary sources.

Dr. S K Sharma, Chairman of the **Programme Committee** said that the Draft of the Certificate prepared for use by the Secretary for honouring Members of the Age of 80 years patterned on the Certificate used by the CSIR Pensioners Welfare Committee was approved and the Committee will meet to decide any further addition to be made in this regard. He also suggested inviting Dr. Lieut Gen A K Bakshi to give a talk at the next meeting of the Forum.

Publication Committee: As Dr. R Bhattacharya had regretted his inability to attend the meeting as he was to be at Bangalore on that day, Shri G K Arora apprised the members about the expenditure of Rs. 15,500/- that had been incurred on the publication of the November 2007 Issue of the Newsletter. The Committee felt that the scope of the Newsletter may be reviewed by the Committee, and the joys of the members of the Forum may also be reflected therein. In this regard. Shri R C Dhawan informed that he had been blessed with a Grandson on April 9, 2008. It was also felt that two issues of the Newsletter may be published per year, restricting the expenditure to Rs. 3,000/- for an issue.

In Regard to the **Welfare Committee**, the main issue which required to be considered by this Committee, was the recommendations of the Sixth Central Pay Commission and its effect on the Members of the Forum. In addition, it had been advised to consider ways and means of making the Room allotted to the Forum functional. Dr. R G Sharma had also been requested to suggest Re-constitution of this Committee.

Dr. Kailash Chandra, Chairman of the **Scientific Affairs Committee**, drew the attention of the Members to the suggestions that he had sent by e-mail from Chicago, and which had already been incorporated in the Newsletter Issue No. 4, November, 2007. It was felt that it would first be necessary for the Forum to ascertain the views of Director, NPL regarding the commitment of NPL for incurring the expenditure particularly in regard to the revised document on **SI Units of Measurement**, for which Dr. S V Gupta was prepared to do the spade work. A copy of that document published earlier was available with Dr. V N Bindal. It was felt that a meeting with Dr. Vikram Kumar may be arranged.

In regard to the **Scholarship Committee** Shri V P Wasan had already presented a Financial Report in respect of the various Scholarships & Awards, and mention had also been made by the Secretary in his Status Report about the issue of the Specially designed Certificates also to the Awardees on 26th September, 2007 by Dr. Vikram Kumar, Director, NPL. Presentation of additional report of the Committee was postponed as Dr. A P Jain had suddenly become very ill.

11. Utilization of the Room Allotted to the Forum: Dr. V S Panwar mentioned about the stuffiness in the room for want of ventilation. Dr. Bindal, mentioned about his approaching Dr. Vikram Kumar for a Table and chairs for the Conference Room which are expected to be provided shortly. He had further requested the Secretary to approach Director, NPL for some more furniture. It may take some time for the various issues to be settled one by one.

12. Honouring Members of the Age of 80 years and above: This issue had been already covered under Item 10;
13. Venue, Date & Time for the next General Body Meeting: It was decided to have the next General Body Meeting as early as possible. The main item on Agenda for that meeting should be the Approval of the Reformulated Aims & Objects of the Forum as approved by this Committee under Item 7 above. If it is possible to accommodate the talk on “Mysteries of Life” as suggested by Dr. S K Sharma, under Item 10 above, the same may also be done. The detailed programme for the meeting may be drawn by the President.

It was also decided that since informing the members about the meetings by e-mail alone has not proved to be very effective, this means of communication may only supplement the issue of the notices for the meeting by Courier/ Post.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the chair.

STATUS REPORT BY THE SECRETARY

(Ref: Agenda Item 5)

NOTE: *There was an Inadvertent Error in the Numbering of the Various Items of Agenda for the Meeting circulated vide letter dated April 8, 2005. A copy of the Revised Letter incorporating these corrections will be placed on the Table at the Time of the meeting. The Reference to the various Items of Agenda, mentioned below, is to the New Numbering of the various items.*

1. Dr. A F Chhapgar (Ref: Agenda Item 2): It was learnt that Dr. A F Chhapgar breathed his last on February 7, 2008. The members of the Committee are requested to observe a two-minute silence in his memory and pass a Resolution which may be sent to his son Shri Fram A Chhapgar.

2. Twentieth Meeting of The Management Committee (Ref: Agenda Item 3): The Minutes of the Twentieth Meeting of the Management Committee held on 20th June 2007(as approved by the Chairman), had been e-mailed on 19. 07. 2007 to Dr. R Bhattacharyya, Dr. S V Gupta, Dr. P C Jain, Dr. O P Bahl, Dr. Kailash Chandra, Dr. S P Singal, Shri V P Wasan, V R Singh, Dr. V N Bindal and Dr. S P Varma. **Hard copies** of the same were also sent by **Courier on 24. 07. 2007** to Dr. V R Singh (as desired), Dr. S K Sharma, Dr. V S Panwar, Dr. A P Jain, Shri K N Bhatnagar, Shri R C Dhawan, Shri Subhsh Chandra, Mrs. Shashikala Shastri, Shri P K Mittal and Dr. V N Bindal (as desired), All of them were requested to send their comments on the Minutes of the meeting and also to initiate action on decisions relating to them. A copy of the same will be tabled at the time of the meeting.

As no comments from any members had been received, the minutes of this meeting may be confirmed.

3. Follow-up Action on the Decisions taken at the above Meeting (Ref: Agenda Item 4): The following action has been taken:

1. **Shri Ashish Shawney :** The Resolution passed on the demise of Shri Ashish Shawney was sent to his Shri Kewal Krishan, under Certificate of Posting, on 25. 06. 2007.

2. **Shri Tri Bhawan Sharma:** He has been inducted as a New Member [Membership No. 174].

3. **Registration of Forum as a Society:** The Forum has been registered as a Society with the Registrar of Societies, National Capital Territory of Delhi on 29. 10. 2007 – (**Registration No. S/ 60178/ 2007**).

4. **Exemption Under Income Tax Act 1961:** In response to the application filed on 31. 05. 2007, for exemption of Income Tax under Section 12 of the Income Tax Act, information, as desired, was furnished on November 6 and 7, 2007. However, vide their letter dated 29 November, 2007, our application was rejected primarily on the grounds that the activities undertaken by the Forum are too varied and the funds received by the Forum for Scholarships & Awards could be used for activities other than those which could justify our claim for exemption.

It was observed that in order to be eligible for registration u/s 12AA of the I.T. Act, 1961, the following conditions should be satisfied:

1. The objects of the trust should be charitable in nature;

2. The activities of the trust should be genuine

Following this response, the Members of the Rules & Regulations Committee (Dr. S V Gupta, Dr. P C Jain, Dr. V S Panwar, Shri V P Wasan and Shri G K Arora), as also Dr. V N Bindal, Dr. A P Jain and Dr. O P Bahl, were consulted for their suggestions for reformulation of the Aims & Objects of the Forum. Further, Dr. V N Bindal and Dr. A P Jain also consulted Income Tax Advisors in this regard. It is proposed to Reformulate the Aims & Objects of the Forum, vide **Agenda Item 7**.

Copies of the Existing Aims & Objects mentioned in the Memorandum of Association of the Forum, as also the Revised Aims & Objects that have been formulated, will be placed on the table at the time of the meeting.

5. **Newsletter:** The Special Issue of the Forum’s Newsletter on ‘**Holistic Health Care**’ was released on November 30, 2007.

6. **Revision of the Membership Form:** The Revised Membership Form had been placed on the table at the last meeting of the Management Committee, and the same is being used now. The Reverse Side of the Form may, however, need to be modified again in the light of the Revised Aims & Objectives of the Forum.

7. **Sixth Central Pay Commission:** The Commission has submitted its report to the Government and some highlights of it have also appeared in the Press. It is learnt that the Report can be accessed at the Website <http://www.6pc.in>, and this has been brought to the notice of Dr. R G Sharma who also replaces Dr. V R Singh as Chairman of the Welfare Committee (**Ref: Agenda Item 9**).

8. **Scholarships & Awards:** Scholarships (2007) were awarded by Dr. Vikram Kumar, Director, NPL, on September 26, 2007. **Specially designed certificates** were also presented to the awardees. Detailed report in this regard will be presented under **Item No. 10.6.**

4. Forum's Meetings on August 14, 2007 and November 30, 2007: Though no meeting of the Management Committee could be held after the last Meeting of this Committee, two meetings of the Forum were held on August 14, and on November 30, 2007. The main attraction at the First of these meetings was the Inauguration of the Room No. 103, Force Standard Annex, NPL, by Dr. Vikram Kumar, Director, NPL. At the second of these meetings, the **November 2007 Issue of the Forum's Newsletter on Holistic Health Care** was released. Befitting the occasion, an Invited talk by Dr. Ravinder. K Tuli, Founder of Society of Holistic Advancement of Medicine – SOHAM, and also Senior Consultant & Head of Deptt. of Holistic Medicine, Indraprastha Apollo Hospitals, New Delhi, on “**Holistic Vision of Health**”, was also arranged on that day.

5. Appointment of Chartered Accountant (Ref: Agenda Item 6): So far the Accounts of the Forum are being Audited Internally by Shri P K Mittal. It may now be necessary to appoint a Chartered Accountant for Auditing the Accounts of the forum annually as is the general practice followed by Registered Societies.

7. Management Committee (Ref: Agenda Item 9) : President has nominated Dr. Ram Gopal Sharma on the Management Committee in place of Dr. Ved Ram Singh who has not been able to participate in the deliberations of the Management Committee on account of his frequent visits abroad. This change has been made in the Letterhead notifying the present meeting of the Management Committee.

8. Area Committees (Ref: Agenda Item 10): Reports on the various Committees will be presented by the Chairmen / Co-Chairmen/ Conveners of the various Committees.

9. Utilization of the Room Allotted to the Forum (Ref: Agenda Item 11): The Welfare Committee had considered this issue, but felt that this need to be discussed by the Management Committee. Presently, Dr. V S Panwar has taken charge of the Room and has been keeping it open for some time. 10. Honouring Members of the Age of 80 years & above (Ref: Agenda Item 12): The Programme Committee was to formulate a proposal in this regard as decided at the last meeting of the Forum. In the light of a Certificate Issued to Shri S C Vahisith by CSIR Pensioners Welfare Association on his attaining the age of 80, a draft of the Certificate that our Forum may issue to such members was also prepared by the Secretary and sent to the Chairman of the Programme Committee.

Out of the list of Members of the Forum who could have been honoured by the Forum as per the list circulated with the Secretary's Report for the last meeting of the Management Committee, three members have since expired. 11.
